

THRA Members only Excursion - Sunday 20 March 2016 -1pm

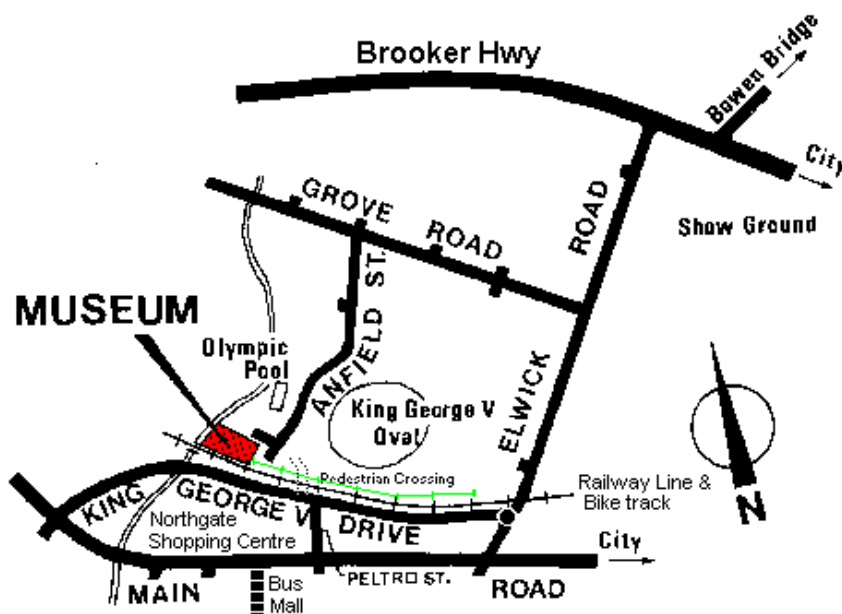
Tasmanian Transport Museum



Our March excursion will be to the Hobart suburb of Glenorchy to the Tasmanian Transport Museum. As the 20th is the third Sunday there will be short demonstration train trips in the museum vintage carriages pulled by one of their steam locomotives.

We will be taken on a special guided tour of the museum, the exhibits of which include the railway locomotives, railmotors, carriages and wagons, trams, trolley buses, motor buses, stationary steam engines and many other items of historical interest. There is also a display of historical photographs and other small objects as well as the Tasmanian Fire Museum collection.

The museum is located off Anfield Street, Glenorchy, and is opposite the Northgate shopping centre.



Admission will be \$10.00 adults, \$8.00 concession and \$5.00 children which includes unlimited train rides. We will meet in the car park at 1pm and pay **CASH** upon entry.
