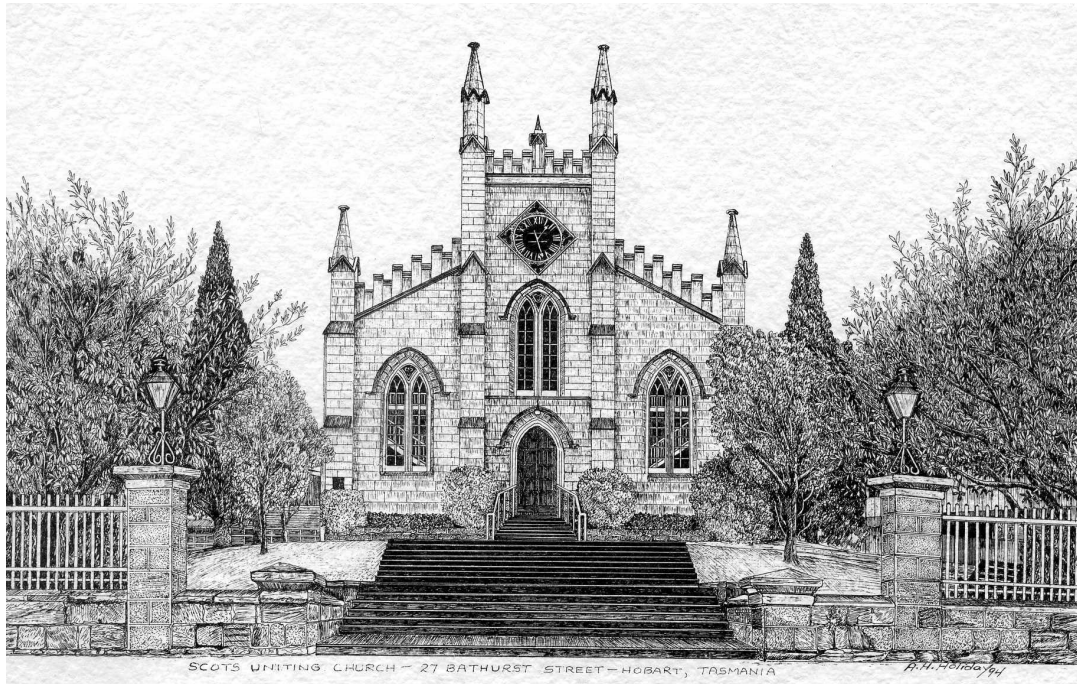


Excursion – Sunday 5 June 2016

Scots-Memorial Church & Museum - 2pm.



Our June Excursion will be to the Scots-Memorial Church and their Museum and Fraser Collection in St Andrew's Hall located behind the church. Robert Mackenzie Fraser was Tasmania's first missionary to the Pacific.

There will be a guided tour of the Scots-Memorial Church, followed by an inspection of the Fraser Collection and Museum in St Andrew's Hall, which was opened for worship in September 1824 and is one of the oldest church buildings in Australia, where we will also enjoy refreshments of Tea-Coffee and biscuits.

Free parking will be available on the day by entering the Church car park off 29 Bathurst Street. Due to the Sunday Farm Gate Market, this section of Bathurst Street may only be accessible via Argyle Street from the South or Elizabeth Street from the North. We will meet at **2pm** in front of St Andrew's Hall. Cost is \$5 per person, payable on the day.

If anyone is still interested we might later walk or drive to St Andrew's burial ground in Church Street to inspect the tombstones and headstones from 1829 until 1872 which remain in St Andrew's Park.
